TOURNAMENT RULES AND PROCEDURES TO COMPLETE T.A.F.

HOW TO COMPLETE THIS FORM

- A. Indicate the Tournament Name and the Tournament Dates.
- B. The **TOURNAMENT CLASSIFICATION** is a five-character code consisting of the Tournament Season, Tournament Jurisdiction, Tournament Type, and Tournament Team Type. Check one box in each section. For example, the classification for an Inter-Provincial Recreational Club Team Tournament would be **"0-IPRC"** and you would insert a ✓ in the following boxes:
G O G I P G R G C
- C. An **IN** classification is a tournament open to teams from other countries. There is a **tournament host fee** for each **IN** tournament.
- D. A **NA** classification is a tournament open to teams from Canada and the U.S.A. only. There is a **tournament host fee** for each **NA** tournament.
- E. An **IP** classification is a tournament open to teams from other Canadian provinces. There is a **tournament host fee** for each **IP** tournament.
- F. An **ID** classification is a tournament open to teams from more than one District Association.
- G. A **DT** classification is a tournament open to teams which are all from the same District Association.
- H. If your tournament is going to be more than one classification, you must complete a separate application form for each classification.
- I. The team classification indicates which teams may participate in the tournament. Recreational Outdoor teams may only participate in **R** classifications. Competitive Amateur Outdoor teams may only participate in **C** or **O** classifications. Professional outdoor teams may only participate in **P** or **O** classifications. Amateur Indoor Teams may only participate in **I** and **O**. Professional Indoor Teams may only participate in **PI** and **OI**.
- J. The team type indicates whether the tournament is for Club Teams, Select Teams or All-Star Teams. Club Teams may only participate in **C** Type tournaments, Select Teams in **S** type tournaments, and All-Star Teams may only participate in **A** Type tournaments.
- K. You indicate the age and gender divisions by inserting a ✓ in the applicable box(es). The top section for **"MINI SOCCER"** is for **"female"**, **"male"** and **"mixed"** teams. The middle section for **"YOUTH SOCCER "** is for **"female"**, **"male"** and **"mixed"** teams the lower section is for **"SENIOR SOCCER"** and includes **"female"**, **"male"** and **"mixed"** teams.
- L. Indicate the name of the Tournament Host Organization (which must be either a **Club, League, or District Association**). Insert a ✓ in the appropriate box at the right.
- M. Provide the name of the Chair of the Tournament Organizing Committee.
- N. Provide the mailing address, telephone numbers (daytime and evening), fax number, Internet E-Mail Address, Lotus Notes E-mail Address, entry deadline, entry fee, the name of the city/town where the tournament is being played, and the number of teams expected to play in the tournament.
- O. The Club or League hosting the tournament must sign the **CLUB/LEAGUE APPROVAL** section. An elected Officer of the Club or League must sign on behalf it.
- P. The Club or League then submits the **TAF** to its District Association or, in the case of a Provincial or Regional League, directly to the O.S.A..
- Q. The Tournament Rules (for all tournaments) and the Tournament Application Fee (for International, North American, and Inter-Provincial Tournaments only) must accompany the application form.

NOTE: The amount of the Tournament Application Fee can be obtained from your District Association.

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Read Competitions' Policies 4.0 to 11.0 (ie., Tournaments) and Competitions Policies' 12.0 and 13.0 (Team Travel) for the complete Published Rules governing tournaments and teams participating in tournaments.
2. A **District Tournament** and an **Inter-District Tournament** requires the approval of the Host Club's District Association.
3. **Inter-Provincial Tournaments** also require the approval of O.S.A.
4. **North American Tournaments** also require the approval of the C.S.A..
5. **International Tournaments** also require the approval of F.I.F.A..
6. The deadlines for submitting Tournament Applications are:
120 days - International Tournament
120 days - North American Tournament
90 days - Inter-Provincial Tournament
30 days - Inter-District Tournament
30 days - District Tournament
before the first day of the tournament.
7. A copy of the Tournament Rules must accompany the application.
8. With regard to **International Tournaments** the Tournament Host Organization must include in its rules or in the literature promoting the tournament: **"that all teams must have permission from their governing organization to participate in the tournament"** and **"that all teams must be covered by medical and liability insurance"**. This is a FIFA regulation to which there must be strict adherence. The copy of the rules or promotional literature must be included with the application as proof that this has been done.
9. Not later than seven days prior to the tournament, each participating team must supply proof to the Tournament Host Organization that: **"it has the permission of its governing organization to participate in the tournament and that it has the required medical and liability insurance"**.
10. Each player must provide the appropriate registration document in order to play in the tournament.
11. The District Association approving the tournament shall appoint, or delegate the appointment of, a discipline committee to act at the tournament.
12. The District Association approving the tournament shall appoint, or delegate the appointment of, referees to officiate at the tournament.
13. Only referees on the O.S.A. Official List Of Referees may officiate at the tournament.
14. The Tournament Host Organization shall forward misconduct reports for **ALL** cautions and dismissals, together with a **"Tournament Discipline Summary Report"** to its District Association within 48 hours after the completion of the tournament.
15. a) The tournament report for an International, North American or Inter-Provincial Tournament must be submitted to OSA and District Association within 30 days of the tournament's completion.
b) The tournament report for a Inter-District and District Tournament must be submitted to the District Association within 30 days of the tournament's completion.
